MADRID VLR: INNOVATIVE WORK IN MONITORING IMPACT

GLOBAL URBAN MONITORING FRAMEWORK (GUMF)

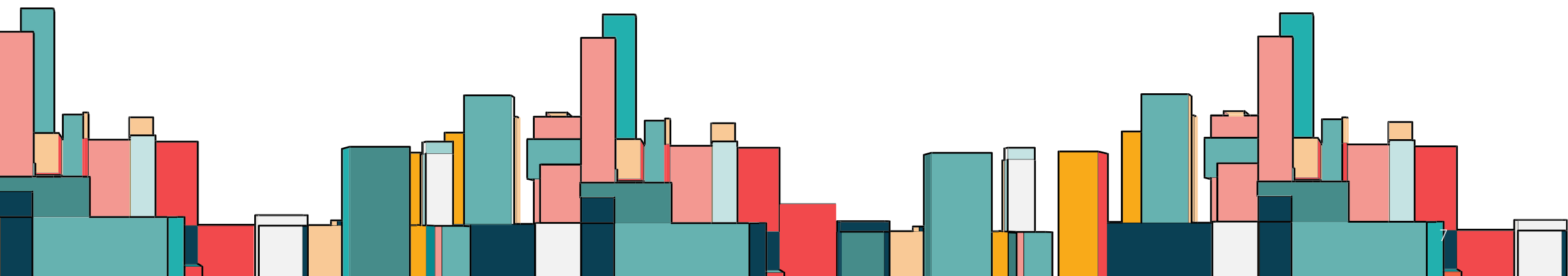
- Madrid has supported the development of the GUMF that allows the monitoring of the cities' progress globally.
- Madrid VLR is one of the first cities to apply the GUMF.

URBAN FUNCTIONAL AREA DEFINITION

- Supports efforts of EU (with OECD & World Bank) for harmonised definition of cities.
- Better understand urban influence and processes.

MEASURING IMPACT OF TWO FLAGSHIP INITIATIVES

- Madrid Nuevo Norte, a large urban regeneration project in the north of the city.
- Climate neutrality roadmap of Madrid.

- Impact of the pandemic is however noticeable on several indicators.



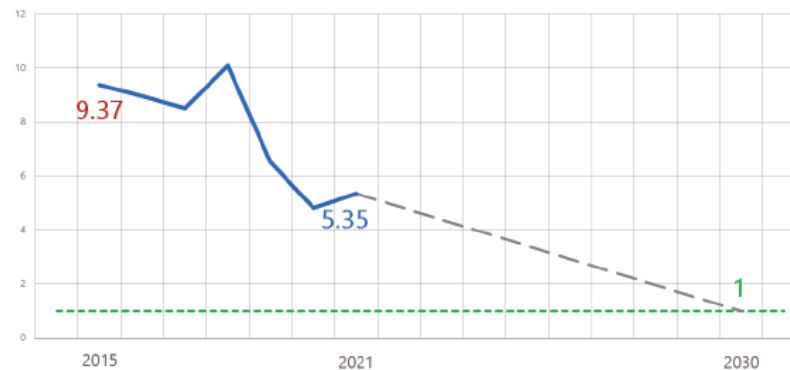

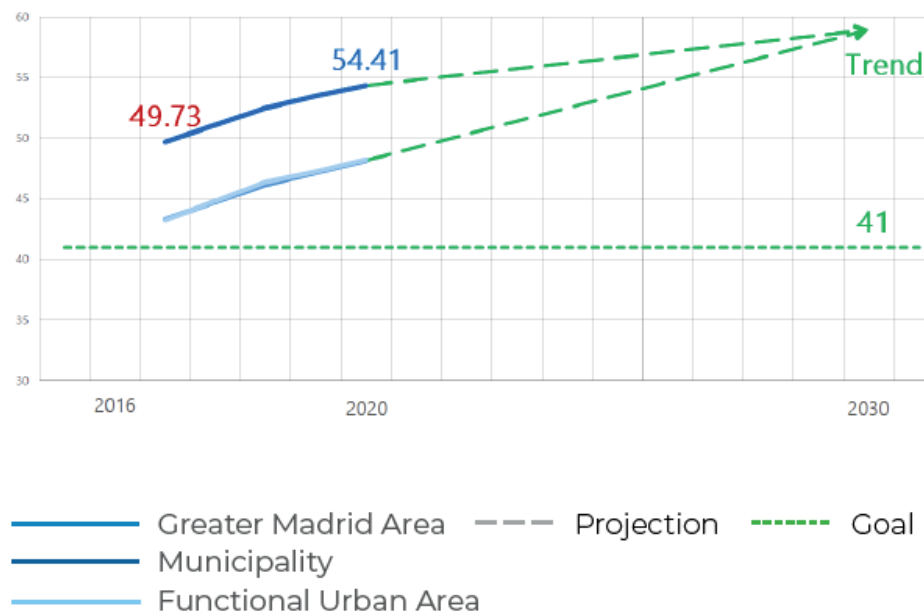


MADRID MUNICIPALITY AND FUNCTIONAL URBAN AREA (FUA)

- FUA is composed of a city and its commuting zone.
- Based on EU-OECD methodology.
- FUA of Madrid in this VLR is composed of 166 municipalities.
 - 7 million inhabitants (compared to 3.3 in the municipality of Madrid).

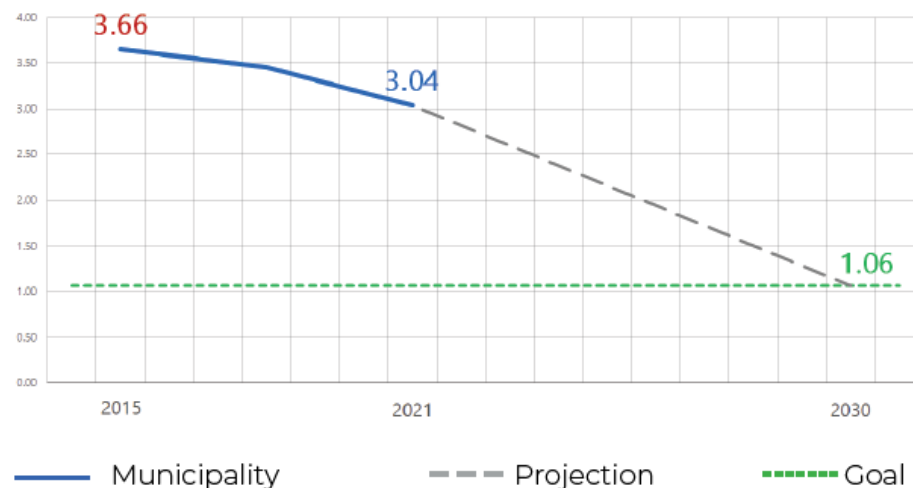


CLIMATE NEUTRALITY ROADMAP OF MADRID

- Reduce GHG emissions in the city by 65% in 2030, compared to 1990, and achieve climate neutrality by 2050.
- GHG emissions have decreased by 23% compared to 1990 (by 40% compared to 2005).
- Multiple and cross-cutting benefits of decarbonization:
 - Health
 - Quality of life
 - Job creation
 - Etc.

The territorial focus on Madrid Nuevo Norte, the largest urban regeneration project in Madrid, shows its clearly positive contributions to SDGs in the city.

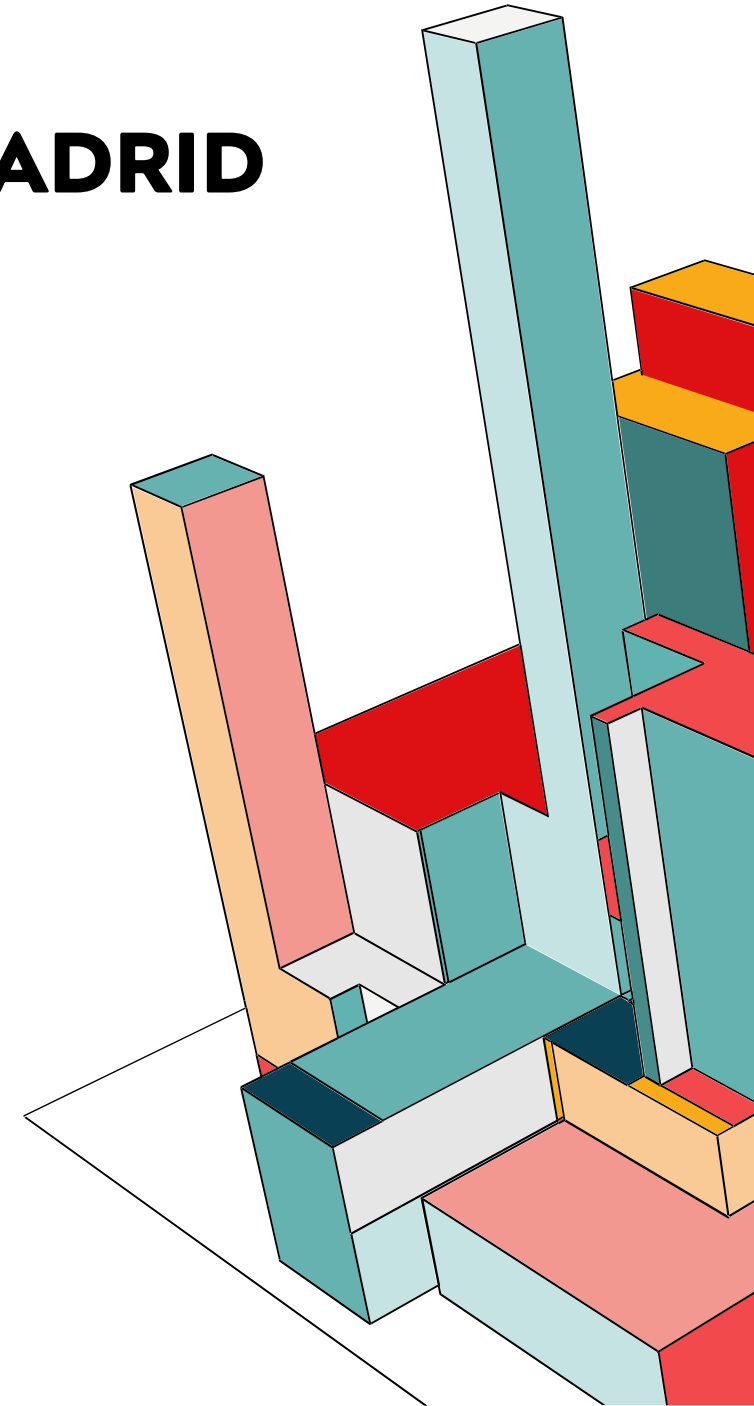
Two initiatives stand out as having a high positive impact on SDG 11:

- Creation of wide green areas and renovated public spaces.

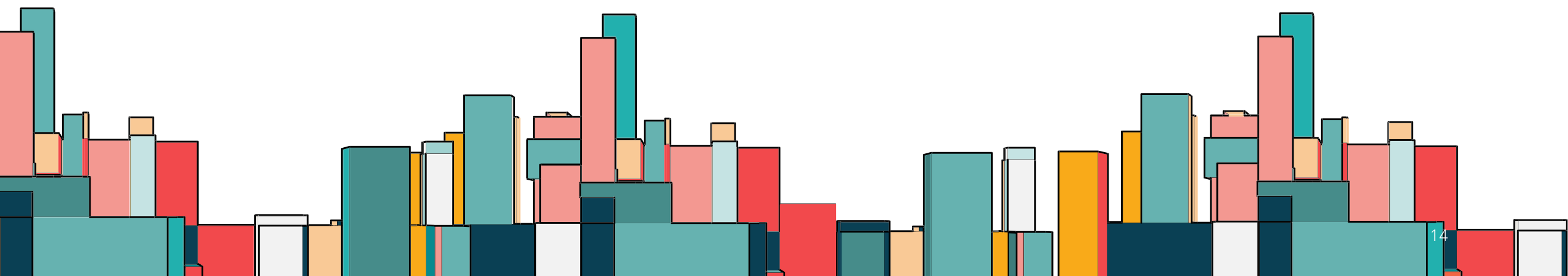
